5010 NDC Codes

If you are using “J” Injection codes for billing you will need to include the NDC number for each CPT Code. In PowerSoftMD go to the Utility Menu, select the “**ECF CPT Comments**” option. Code the “J” Code on the left and its associated **NDC Code prefixed** with “**N4**” on the right. For example: J3301 N4**12345678901**

Please note the NDC number must be 11 digits, you can read below how to format it to get the correct 11 digits.

The “**N4**” is a trigger that Gateway EDI can use to pick up the fact the NDC code follows. This information will be stored on the Electronic Claims Image file right above the actual CPT Code. It’s our understanding all you have to do is fill out the information as described above, and then your Gateway EDI Rep to activate a “Rule” to find this information for you. We do not provide direct support for any other clearing house. If you don’t use Gateway EDI you will have to give this information to your clearing house and work it out with them.

NDC Codes General Information (information we received from Gateway EDI)

You can find the 11-digit NDC number printed on the drug package in a 5-4-2 format. The first five digits of the NDC identify the drug manufacturer, the next four identify the specific product and the last two identify the package size.

If the segments do not have the appropriate number of digits, you will need to add zeros at the beginning of the segment. For example, if the package number is 1234-123-12, you will need to add zeros at the beginning of the segments to reach the required number of digits for the 5-4-2 format (01234-0123-12). When entering the NDC number in the service-line, you will enter all 11 digits without hyphens (01234012312).
