## <u> Windows 8.1 – Tips & Tricks</u>

Want your Windows 8 to start up directly on your Windows Desktop like your old Windows did.

It's easy-to-do, right click on the "Task Bar", select the "Properties" option, click the "Navigation" tab, under the heading "Start screen"; check the following 2 options:

X When I Sign In or Close All Apps on a screen, go to the desktop instead of Start

X Show my desktop background on Start
