## PowerSoftMD – Meaningful Use Stage 2 – Computerized Provider Order Entry - LABORATORY

(Part of Core Objective #1)

**OBJECTIVE**: Use computerized provider order entry (CPOE) for laboratory orders directly entered by any licensed healthcare professional who can enter orders into the medical record per state, local and professional guidelines.

**MEASURE**: More than 30 percent of laboratory orders created by the EP during the EHR reporting period are recorded using CPOE.

**EXCLUSION**: Any EP who writes fewer than 100 laboratory orders during the EHR reporting period.
